Application for Floodplain Building Permit

If you are proposing a project that involves new construction, substantial improvement, damage repair, manufactured housing placement, or other development in a an Area of Special Flood Hazard, as designated by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), then the project must comply with all aspects of Section XIV of the Goshen Zoning Ordinance, "Floodplain Development Ordinance." A map that shows Special Flood Hazard Areas in Goshen is available at the Goshen Town Office. Development in flood hazard areas must comply with special water and sewer system requirements as well as with stringent construction requirements. Before a Building Permit can be issued, you must submit this "Application for Floodplain Building Permit" to the Goshen Building Inspector, *along with the standard "Town of Goshen Application for Building Permit"* and any permits that may be required by state and federal law, including Section 404 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, 33 U.S.C. 1334.

Floodplain Determination: "Area of Special Flood Hazard" is the land in the floodplain within the Town of Goshen subject to a one-percent or greater possibility of flooding in any given year. The area is designated on the FEMA "Flood Insurance Rate Map" (FIRM) as Zone A. Please specify the Effective Date of the FIRM that you are using to make your floodplain determination: _____

Note: Development within the Floodway is prohibited.

Information Required (must be submitted with this application):

1. Site plan that shows the location of all existing and proposed structures; 100-year floodplain boundary; and floodway boundary, if appropriate.
2. Development plans, drawn to scale (no larger than 100 feet per inch), including, where applicable: details for anchoring structures; elevation, in relation to National Geodetic Vertical Datum (NGVD), of lowest floor (including basement); detail of floodproofing of utilities and other service facilities, particularly those located below the first floor; details of enclosures below the first floor; and materials being used to resist flood damage.
3. Design and location of water and sewer systems to minimize or eliminate either the infiltration of flood waters into the systems or discharges from the systems into flood waters.
4. Plans showing the extent of any watercourse relocation and/or landform alteration.

Certifications:

FEMA requires the applicant to furnish the following items for the Building Inspector's permanent files:

1. The as-built elevation (in relation to NGVD) of the lowest floor (including the basement, if any).
2. The as-built elevation (in relation to NGVD) to which the structure was floodproofed, if any.
3. FEMA Elevation Certificate (residential structures)
4. FEMA Elevation Certificate and/or Floodproofing Certificate (non-residential structures).
