CONTINUATION OF PUBLIC HEARING  
AUGUST 20, 2009

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Thomas Lawton, Peta Brennan, Bob Johnson, Cindy Phillips, Allen Howe, and Sue Peacock, Planning Board Secretary.

Mr. Lawton spoke and stated that the first matter on the agenda is the continuation of the application of Newport Sand & Gravel for a special exception. This matter has been continued from July 21<sup>st</sup> to tonight for a deliberative session on the application of Newport Sand & Gravel. Mr. Lawton had indicated that during a meeting with the counsel, there were concerns on how the Board would proceed once the public hearing was to close. Mr. Lawton stated that there was an understanding with counsel that the way the Board would proceed with the procedure was that there would be a designated individual to draft a proposed motion/judgment for the Board to use as the operative document to start commencing discussion for their decision at the deliberative session. Mr. Lawton stated that process has commenced and he has received communication from Attorney Waugh stating he was assisting a Board member with the procedure as discussed earlier. Based upon how far down that avenue, the Board member and Attorney Waugh's assistance had proceeded; it did not appear that the Board would have a proposed motion/judgment to start off the deliberative session. Mr. Lawton stated that it was suggested by a Board member that the deliberative session should be continued to a date when that could be concluded with the Board members and Attorney Waugh. Attorney Waugh indicated that the earliest dates could be either August 26, 31, September 1 or 2. The Board and Attorney Britain agree that September 1 would be a convenient date. Ms. Brennan made a motion to continue the public hearing until September 1, Mr. Johnson seconded, and all were in favor.

Mr. Howe spoke of the upcoming OEP Annual Fall Planning and Zoning Conference. This conference is scheduled for Saturday, October 17, 2009 at the Mountain Club on Loon, Lincoln NH. Mr. Howe distributed copies from the email he received to all Board members.

The public hearing was adjourned at approximately 7:20 p.m.
