Minutes of November 1, 2014
Site Review of Anderson and Davis Pits**

Meeting called to order at 10:07 am.

Steve Bursey appointed full member for this meeting.

A walk through of the Anderson pit was conducted and the following observations and/or changes from the 2013 site visit are noted below:

- Esker is down
- Top soil is available for reclamation
- Reclamation of Phase 1 is in process
- Per D. Fraser, Cameron Sod Farms will be in the pit in the spring to reseed the hill that is visible from Route 10. This section was previously seeded and due to heavy rains will need to be partially reseeded.
- All equipment is out for the season
- Water mitigation, silt management and roadways all appear to be in place and functioning as expected
- The board walked the site of Phase 2

A walk through of the Davis pit was conducted and the following observations and/or changes from the 2013 site visit are noted below:

- Davis pit is in the process of reclamation
- Only a small portion of the front of the pit is active
- No significant changes from the 2013 site visit
