

**Town of Goshen  
Select Board Meeting  
Minutes of Meeting  
June 28, 2021**

Present: Dianne Craig, Steven Smith, Derek Tremblay, Alicea Bursey, Cindy Rouillard.

The meeting came to order at 6:32 pm

- The Pledge of Allergist was Recited.
- The check reports were reviewed and signed.
- Steve made a motion to accept the June 14<sup>th</sup> minutes with changes. Dianne 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor.
- Dianne updated the Select Board on the transfer station. Two new people were hired. Pete Williams and Dennis Giannotti are no longer employed at the transfer station. Alicea stated a person from Tippicanone Campground told her that the recycling policy is out of line. Tax payers pay property tax into the system that supports the transfer station. (Per the 2018 Transfer Station Ordinance states residents only can use the pay as you throw program).
- Brickyard Bridge will cost \$700 to plank.
- Dianne signed the notice of award, notice to proceed, and the owner and contractor contract to do the repairs on the Lempster Coach Bridge. K.A. Stevens will be doing the job.
- There are chairs that are being stored at Bobby Lamb's house that were in the grange hall. The chairs were used for the town hall before they were replaced. The select board will ask Allen Greenhalgh if he wants the chairs to sell at his business Old Man's Junk. Steve made a motion to ask Allan Greenhalgh from Old Man's Junk Consignment if he wants the chairs. Dianne 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor.
- Dianne gave an update on the grange.
- Derek gave an update on the Sunapee Mtn Advisory Committee. Cindy will send a letter stating Derek will be the designated person for Goshen to sit on the committee.
- Cindy will get sympathy cards to send to Mrs. Andersen and Chief Andersen for the passing of Ed Andersen, Sr.
- Alicea went over the broad band contract with the Board. Certain items on the contract need to be addressed. The Select board will go over the contract and bring changes if needed to the next meeting.
- Dianne asked Cindy to call the conservation to see if they appointed a chair to the conservation.
