Inspection of Anderson Pit (off Route 10)

The Planning Board toured the Anderson Pit, the excavation site continues to be clean and orderly with only authorized equipment onsite. Storage area is clean and in good order. NSG is currently working in the upper portion of the pit.

The upper pit will bench down roughly mid-season in 2022 and is planned to come within 100 feet of the tree line to maintain requisite setbacks. The 2021 season is expected to wrap up in November.

The Planning Board found no areas of concern in the Anderson pit.

Inspection of Davis Pit (off Lear Hill Road)

The Planning Board also toured the Davis pit, as with the Anderson pit, the excavation site continues to be clean and orderly. No, equipment was on site at the time of the inspection.
