

BULKY WASTE

BULKY WASTE, is defined by Env-Sw 102.23 as large items that cannot be handled by normal solid waste processing, collection or disposal methods.

PLEASE SEE ATTENDANT BEFORE YOU DISPOSE OF THE FOLLOWING:

APPLIANCES ("white goods") – see Fee Schedule

Because they may contain CFC's and/or PCB's refrigerators, microwaves, and air conditioners must be stored separately so that contaminants can be extracted prior to their removal.

Refrigerator and freezer doors must be removed in advance and all plastic or metal shelving must be disposed of in the appropriate bin.

Stoves, dishwashers, washing machines, clothes dryers, and vacuum cleaners can be disposed of in the metals bin only.

FURNITURE – see Fee Schedule

MATTRESSES – see Fee Schedule

Place upright behind the plastic bin on the lower road

TIRES – see Fee Schedule

NO RIMS – must be stored in a closed container (see Attendant)

ELECTRONIC WASTE – see Fee Schedule

These items contain CRT's which contain lead so they must be handled and stored in a certain manner.

See Attendant to dispose of the following items:

Computers – towers, monitors, laptops
DVD players VCR players Televisions

METALS – see Fee Schedule or check with Attendant
small metal countertop appliances (toaster, toaster oven)
gas grills with NO PROPANE TANK
other metal household goods – (see Attendant)

PROPANE TANKS – see Fee Schedule - GIVE TO ATTENDANT
up to 20 lbs. - MUST BE EMPTY
larger than 20 lbs. NOT ACCEPTED
