

PROHIBITED WASTE:

There are many HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) items that are **NOT ACCEPTED** at the Goshen Transfer Station and Recycling Facility. Prohibited household items include:

- Adhesives
- Asbestos
- Alcohol
- Animal carcasses
- Antifreeze
- Asbestos
- Battery acid
- Bullets
- Drain cleaners (acid and basic)
- Dynamite
- Ether (old)
- Explosives
- Fire extinguishers
- Fireworks
- Gaseous substances
- Gasoline
- Gun powder
- Aerosol cans with flammable propellants
- Any item that chemically reacts with air or water
- Any waste generated outside New Hampshire
- Contaminated soil and other absorbent material

This list is not all-inclusive.

If you are uncertain whether an item or material is disposable, PLEASE ASK AN ATTENDANT.

DEMOLITION

Inert construction and demolition debris is defined by Env-Sw 103.26 as “construction and demolition debris which is comprised of materials that do not degrade, combust or generate leachate” as follows:

Asphalt	Drywall	Plaster
Brick	Fiberglass	Plastic (not #1-7)
Carpeting	Insulation	Porcelain fixtures
Cat litter	Lumber	Tile
Concrete	(treated and not treated)	Vinyl

OTHER

- BATTERIES - Lead acid, Lithium, Button cell, Nickel cadmium
Must be given to Attendant for proper handling and storage
- ASH (WOOD) – from household stoves – place with brush in designated area
- BRUSH (under 5” circumference)
- LEAVES – place in compost pile
- FLUORESCENT LIGHTS – CONTAIN MERCURY - DO NOT CRUSH
Must be given to Attendant for proper handling and storage
- CFL lamp
- LED lamp
- Flood lamp
- PCB ballast and non-PCB ballast
- HAL lamp
- UB end/Circle flow
- HID lamp
- 4’ fluorescent
- MOTOR OIL (used) – Must be in a closed container with no other liquid residue and given to Attendant for proper handling
- MERCURY – Thermometers, Thermostats, Relays, Switches
Must be given to Attendant
